After the entry deadline, the BWF Online Group Entry System will send notification to all participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries.

Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline.

Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by Wednesday, 22 September 2021 at 12:00 hrs BWF Headquarters time.

If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday, 21 September 2021 at 23:59 hrs BWF Headquarters time, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints/objections will be entertained after this point.

Online Entry – Hosting Member Association Entries

Eligible player wishing to enter through the hosting Member Association must follow a different process to international entries.

Entry fee (For German players only):

It does not apply to OK, PK and EK national team athletes of the German Badminton Association e.V.

For participants (NK1, NK2 and non-federal cadres) who are members of badminton clubs State associations (BLV) are reported, including 19% VAT: 40 € for singles and 25 € per player for doubles.

The entry fee must be paid against the invoice before the start of the competition. The registration fee is also payable if players are subsequently added to the field. The accreditation is handed over when the registration fee is paid.

Withdrawals

The management of withdrawals will be run in accordance with BWF GCR 13 and 14.

Member Associations can withdraw their entries through the BWF Online Group Entry system until the last date of withdrawal without penalty (see Key Dates Section).

Withdrawals made after this date will incur a penalty in accordance with the BWF Table of Offences and Penalties (BWF Statute 2.5).

Please ensure that the Tournament Referee and Host Organiser are notified immediately in writing, clearly stating the reason for the withdrawal.

Reserves:

It is mandatory for players on the reserve list that wish to be considered for promotion, to submit the pre-arrival negative COVID-19 PCR test certificate to covid19@hylo-open.de, events.admin@bwfbadminton.org with the test dated 72 hours prior to arrival in Germany. This also includes players living in Germany. This test is at the player's own cost. If the pre-arrival negative test certificate has not been submitted for a player on the reserve list, the next eligible reserve (i.e. reserve who has submitted pre-arrival certificate) will be contacted instead.

All reserve players must then arrive in Saarbrücken and undertake the arrival test at the official hotels by **10:00 on Monday 1 November** in order to be eligible to compete on Tuesday and / or Wednesday. This test will be paid for by the host, for players who are promoted to the main draw.

3. Tournament Details

Prize Money

A prize fund of USD\$320,000 will be distributed in accordance with BWF Statute 5.3.5, and awarded as per the table below.

Distribution of prize money is in accordance with BWF regulations. Income tax will be deducted according to German tax regulations. Tax to be paid to German tax office will be retained from the prize money and paid directly. The actual withholding percentage of income tax: 15,83 %

A limited number of additional accreditations passes for approved Team Officials will be available for purchase at a fee of USD\$150, charged to the respective Member Association, and payable at the tournament. **The additionally accredited Team Officials will have to bear the cost of the mandatory PCR tests conducted in connection with the tournament. The cost of the PCR tests will be updated soon.**

The fee to replace any lost or damaged accreditation passes will be USD\$100 on each occasion, charged to the respective Member Association.

The tournament reserves the right to refuse entry into any accredited venue or area or service (e.g. transportation) as a result of damaged or missing accreditation.

The fraudulent use of accreditation is strictly prohibited, and will result in access rights being removed, and penalties being applied.

Medical Services

A medical officer and physiotherapist service will be available during the tournament, free of charge to players.

An appointment system will operate to ensure equal opportunities for all players, if needed. Teams can use plinths with their own physiotherapist as well.

A tournament doctor will be available during play.

Anti-Doping

Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any

way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.

4. Travel & Visa Details

Transport

Due to COVID-19 testing arrival is allowed only on **Saturday, 30 October and Sunday 31 October 2021**.

Finalists from the YONEX French Open 2021 are permitted to arrive on **Monday 1 November morning** but are **unlikely to be able to practice** in the competition hall before their first match on Wednesday.

All **reserve players** (including those living in Germany) must arrive in Saarbrücken and undertake the arrival test at the official hotels by **10:00 am on Monday 1 November** in order to be eligible to compete on Tuesday and / or Wednesday.

Due to COVID-19 testing all **Monday arrivals including reserves** are **unlikely to be able to practice** in the main hall.

Complimentary transportation will be provided by the tournament between the official venues: competition venue, official hotel(s), practice venue (if separate from the competition venue), and the following transportation hubs:

- **Transportation from Saarbrücken Airport is free of charge.**

3. Hotels

It is a condition of entry that all participants must stay in the official hotels listed below. The hotels will not be exclusive to the tournament however segregated breakfast areas will be available.

4. COVID-19 Testing

The COVID-19 testing programme will be carried out as follows:

- All players and team entourage must submit a pre-arrival negative Covid-19 PCR test with the test dated within **72 hours before their arrival** into Germany to the following e-mail addresses:

This includes players living in Germany. It is recommended to keep a physical copy of the certificate in case it is needed at the airport or arrival point.

On arrival to the official hotel an arrival Covid-19 PCR test will be carried out. Players and team entourage are not permitted to leave their hotel rooms until a negative result has been obtained (up to 24 hours). For this reason, players are not allowed to practice until a negative PCR test is received from the local host.

On Friday 5 November all players and entourage will be tested again to ensure the Green Zone is continuously free from infection. Players do not need to quarantine whilst waiting for the results.

5. Face masks

Medical face masks (surgical masks) or masks of the standards KN95/N95 or FFP2 or higher must be worn.

6. Positive case protocols

In the event of a positive test the participant and direct/close contacts are required to follow the instructions of the LOC, BWF and the local authorities at all times which may result in players being withdrawn from the tournament. More information on these protocols will be released closer to the event.

7. Reserves

It is mandatory for players on the reserve list that wish to be considered for promotion, to submit the pre-arrival negative COVID-19 PCR test certificate to covid19@hylo-open.de, events.admin@bwfbadminton.org with the test dated 72 hours prior to arrival in Germany.
